DESCRIPTION: Come on your own, with a Guiding friend, or with a Patrol. This is your chance to enjoy your love of the arts and take full advantage of a wonderful seaside setting. Activities could include swimming, archery, dance, drama, crafts, painting and music. Meet girls from all over, have fun and make friends. Stay in a residential building or permanent hut at Kwi Kwa, Galalina, Hideaway, Brock or Hi Yu Win. Travel is the responsibility of each participant or patrol. Camp Olave is a 45 minute ferry ride from Vancouver via the Horseshoe Bay Terminal, followed by a 30 minute vehicle ride on the Sechelt Peninsula. We will offer bus transportation for participants from the Langdale terminal to and from the camp. Detailed instructions will be sent with the kit list, travel, tee and hat order and permission forms. Guiders are needed for all aspects of camp.

WHO: If you are a Brownie, Guide, Pathfinder or Ranger born in 2010 or earlier, this camp is for you. Come individually, with a friend or as a patrol with a Guider. Guiders are needed and are welcome to come individually.

COST: \$400.00 per girl. Full payment is due with application form. Make cheques payable to Girl Guides of Canada. Postdate the cheque to April 30, 2018. Cheques will not be deposited prior to April 30, 2018 and only if there is still room.

QUALIFICATIONS: All girls must be members of Girl Guides of Canada – Guides du Canada and have four (4) nights camping experience (need not be consecutive), at Guide camps or sleepovers, by June 1, 2018

HEALTH FORMS: Include a current completed health form (H.1) for each participant with the application forms. Keep a copy as each participant must also travel with a copy of their health form.

Remember Camp Olave is a large campsite and there will be considerable walking to and from activities.
